The long term aim is to become a Beacon site recognised by the LTA. A tennis coach will be on hand with the overall aim of increasing community playing of tennis.

Individual adult membership (over 18 years) costs £50, family membership (parents and up to two children in the family (aged 5 -18 years) £100 and Junior membership (5-18 years) £25.
