Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 24 March 2011 at the Pavilion, Broomhall Lane, Sunningdale

- 27/11 **Declaration of interest** for items on the agenda: none
- 28/11 **Minutes of the Meeting** of 8th March were signed as a true record
Minutes Part 2 of Council of 8th March was signed as a true record.
- 29/11 **Professional advice**
In the interest of good community relations, Council mandated CG to speak to the Vicar to find a resolution of all difficulties and seek an agreed way forward.
- 30/11 **Tennis kiosk**
ND spoke to paper 30/11 showing a similar kiosk and suggested arrangements for the set up and working of the kiosk. The one provisionally ordered was different to that in the photo in a number of ways, modified for security and practicalities. Council can be reasonably confident that the kiosk can be refunded from S106 money, and operated by Monica. A mains electricity supply will cost approx £500. It would be placed in the grass area close to the tennis courts. The flag stones are assembled. Shelves to be erected by Graeme.
In terms of security, it will have an outside light, fire extinguisher, sturdy locks and a shed alarm.
A rent of £60 per month for 6 months was agreed. The set up costs would be capped at £400 maximum.
Council **agreed** to support this idea as a cost effective way of providing refreshment for the community.
- 31/11 **Cardio workout equipment**
After considerable debate, Council agreed to proceed in principle subject to gathering more information from other Councils using this equipment on their recommendation, durability and maintenance.
- 32/11 Big Society discussion postponed till the next meeting.
